Fines & Fees

Peabody Library is a "Fine Free" Library with the exception of our "Library of Things" & Hotspots.

Library of Things-\$2.00 a day late fee
Hotspots-\$5.00 a day late fee

Accounts are blocked from checking out materials and placing holds when fines & fees reach \$10.00 or have 15 overdue items.

Once an item is **28 days** past due it is considered "**Lost**" and your account will be billed the cost of the item. If the "Lost" item is returned, your account will be credited.

Important Policies to Remember

- **You must have a form of your library card to check out.**
- Cards are not transferable. *Only the library card owner may check out items on their card.*
- Items on hold for another patron may not be renewed.
- You may have a maximum of 30 unfulfilled holds on your account.
- Replacement Evergreen Indiana library cards are \$2.00 unless the account has expired.
- Accounts expire every 2 years and must be updated in person with a valid photo ID with current address or proof of residency.

Frequently Asked Questions

Where can I pay my fees?

You may pay fees on your account at any Evergreen Indiana Library. Peabody Public Library accepts payments with cash, check, debit or credit. There is a small service fee to use a card for payment. You can also pay online using your debit/credit card. A convenience fee does apply and partial payments are not accepted online.

What if my Library card is lost or stolen?

Call the library immediately and we will block your account so no one other than yourself can use your card. Come in to the circulation desk and we will issue you a replacement.

There is a \$2.00 replacement fee for lost cards and you will be required to show proof of ID with your correct address. Children under the age of 18 will need to have a parent or guardian (with photo ID) with them when replacing a card.

How can I renew items?

You can renew items in person at any Evergreen library, over the phone, through your online account or using the Evergreen App. If you come in person or call to renew your materials, please provide your library barcode number.

What services do you offer?

- We offer Notary services at no cost.
- Faxing. \$1.00 a page for Evergreen card holders and \$2.00 a page for non card holders. Fax receiving is no cost.
- Scanning and emailing at no cost.
- Proctoring Services: Educational purposes is at no cost. Licensing is \$10.00.
- Copying. \$.10 a page for black & white, \$.25 a page for color.
- Homebound services for those unable to visit the library. Call 260-244-5541 for more information.
- Public Computers and printing. Price is the same as making a copy located above.
- Appointments for one-on-one computer help.
- Affordable Meeting Rooms for meetings and social events.
- Curb-side Service: Items that have been placed on hold can be delivered right to your car! Park in one of our designated spots and call 260-244-5541.
- Interactive Youth Services department with play area, video gaming area and public computers.

What is a hotspot and what is the policy for checking one out?

A hotspot is a device that provides mobile internet. These devices are limited to Peabody patrons who are 18 years old and over, have held an account for at least 3 months and are in good standing.

They may be checked out for 1 week, and as long as there are no holds on it, you can check it out again.

Hotspots are exempt from our Fine Free program and will incur \$5.00 per day late fee.
