KNIFTY KNITTERS & CROCHETS wisted Headband

Royal Ridge Stitch
Row 1:HDC in second
chain from hook. HDC
across row. CH1.
Row 2: Start in the first
stitch, but in the third
loop of the first HDC in
previous row.
HDC in the the third
loop across the row.

Abbreviations:

HDC: Half Double Crochet CH: Chain

Need:

1 Skein of yarn 5.5 mm crochet hook


Scarf Pattern

- Chain 67
- Crochet the Royal Ridge Stitch for 13 rows.
- Knot & leave a long tail for sewing.

Twisted Headband

• Yarn needle

Using the reverse side, fold one end in half (corner to corner) and then fold the other end in half. You will push the ends together (see photo). Using the tail, sewing the ends together. Knot off, and cut off the leftover yarn. Turn the headband inside out.







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Sand Pattern

Cast on multiples of 2 plus 1.

Row 1: Knit across row Row 2: K1, *p1, k1, rep from *

Rep rows 1 and 2 for pattern

Abbreviations:

K: knit P: Pearl Rep: Repeat

Need;

1 Skein of yarn Size 6 needles

Scarf Pattern

- Cast on 21
- Knit the Sand Pattern for 84 rows
- Cast off, knot & leave a long tail for sewing.

Twisted Headband

• Yarn needle

Using the reverse side, fold one end in half (corner to corner) and then fold the other end in half. You will push the ends together (see photo). Using the tail, sewing the ends together. Knot off, and cut off the leftover yarn. Turn the headband inside out.
